### Roadworks

Repair work on the route de Ligné drinking water network is being carried out from 14 March for approximately 2 months.

The repair of a portion of the road deemed urgent by the A.D.A. for Husson is planned in the course of the year 2022.

## Municipal life and News

#### Deliberations

#### January 2022

#### Decision on the project to extend the housing estate "Le Clos du Mas" 2<sup>nd</sup> phase.

Maisons Charentaises filed a building permit for 4 lots on a plot of 4649m<sup>2</sup>.

This project is a logical continuation and extension of the 1st phase of 4 houses which have been completed and sold.

The Village Council voted in favour to this request.

#### **Properties without owners**

Incorporation of plot YH 82 (Small hill called "Le Peu Chevalier" into the municipal domain.

The Village Council, after deliberation, agreed unanimously, to incorporate this plot referred to in the decrees of February 24 and October 12, 2021.

# 2022 salle de fetes and stadium rental rates

The Village Council, after having deliberated, adopted unanimously, the rate changes proposed for 2022 for the salle de fetes rental.

The city council adopted unanimously the modified prices proposed for 2022. These are available at town hall and on the website.

#### February 2022

#### **Outings grants**

2022 educational courses of the RPI of P'tits Loups and the college of Villefagnan.

This grant was increased in 2021, And the board has decided to maintain the amount at 30€ per student.

#### Application for participation in the prevention project »My house A'Venir" to support seniors citizens.

The city council decided to Respond favourably to this project, which is presented on page 3 of this newsletter.

# Bringing the heating up to standard for the church.

Work is needed to complete the upgrading of the propane gas heater in the the church as it can no longer be used, safely, in its present condition. The estimate from the company CGVCIEL of a amount of €13,779.25 excluding tax was

accepted.

#### March 2022

#### **FFDAC 2022**

Aong the improvements to to be carried out on municipal roads offered by the ADA, eligible for

FDAC, the council retained, unanimously, the repair of a section of the Husson road, deemed most urgent by the Agency, for an amount of €5,659.58 excluding tax, for the FDAC 2022 programme.

#### Agreement with My House A'Venir for April 19

The presentation project "My Maison A'Venir", as part of home support, was received favourably. The date of 19 April 2022 having been agreed, the

Council unanimously authorized the Mayor to sign the agreement to contribute an amount of 100€ paid by the community.

#### **Emergency aid to Ukraine**

Unanimously, the city council decided to grant an emergency aid donation of 500€, to Ukraine, via the External Action Fund of Territorial Communities (FACECO).

#### Campaign to sterilize feral cats

The campaign to sterilize feral cats is now finished in rue du Cantonnier and surrounding area. 7 animals were caught (4 females and three males, one of which was sick and therefore not sterilized).
