# Municipal Budget

The municipal council devoted its meeting of April 14 mainly to the vote of the budget of the municipality. No increase in tax rates. The mayor proposed maintaining the tax rates for property taxes on buildings (44.79%), non-buildings (47.50%) and business property tax (22.19%)

# Roadworks

Repair work on the Route de Bessé drinking water network began on June 7 and will last approximately one month. Work to extend the electricity network and install a lamppost is underway in rue du Cantonnier and work to extend the water network began on June 1, 2022. The installation of a public light at the Clos du Mas is planned to take place soon.

# Town planning

Life in society presupposes respect for certain rules of knowing how to live, many of which are dictated by common sense and elementary good citizenship: respect for others, respect for public and private spaces.

• Trees or other vegetation extending over the public road must not impede the free movement of pedestrians, cars or trucks, public lighting, road signs or the various aerial networks.

• Picking up and removing leaves from public roads is also your responsibility especially in the event of an accident.

• If the maintenance of your garden is carried out by a specialized company, this company must itself remove the plant debris to the recycling centre and not deposit it on the public highway. Don't forget to ask for the certificate of deposit in the recycling centre.

#### SMABACAB



Since January 1, 2019, the SMABACAB (Syndicat Mixte d'Aménagement des Bassins Aume-Couture, Auge et Bief) has been deploying its actions by integrating the GEMAPI competence (Management of Aquatic Environments and Prevention of Floods). To achieve this competence, the Syndicate carries out improvements to the rivers that are favourable to both the quantity and quality of water as well as to aquatic and semi-aquatic ecosystems. The

syndicate has posted, for example, a video presenting the restoration work of the Divise, carried out in 2021 on nearly a kilometer of watercourse. # To stay connected, prune !

Did you know that access to the telephone, television and the internet is partly conditional upon the regular maintenance of the vegetation?

If you are the owner of land or a garden, you are responsible for the maintenance of your plants located near telecommunication networks through clearing operations, grass cutting and especially tree pruning.
