

Municipal Life and What's Going On

Deliberations of the Municipal Council

October 2021:

Additional work has been carried out at the school replacing a window and a dilapidated shutter.

The municipality has decided to give help to the contribution for municipal employees who would like to subscribe to MNT Health and TERRITORIA Prévoyance.

The municipality has decided to subscribe for agents, from the 1st January 2022, to the new service agreement (health, hygiene, safety at work) offered by the management centre of Charente as a replacement to the old contract.

November 2021:

The WPD company offered us a construction project for a solar panel park on the site of the old municipal landfill located on the route de Moussac.

The municipality has decided to remove the revenue control from the canteen in its current form as of November 22, 2021. From December the payments will be made by securities at the perception by T.I.P, among tobacconists, ...

Décember 2021:

Solar panel park project WPD:

The City Council has authorized the Mayor to sign a promise to a emphyteutic lease.

• The municipal council declared itself not in favour of the project for an additional wind turbine on the "Croilières" park in Courcôme.

Remind



Associations News





The association "Les Croq'sentiers" of Charmé held its general assembly on October 9, 2021 in the presence of the mayor, who was thanked by Raymond Boutant, the president of the association, for the granting of the granted subsidy. After reading the status report and the report on activities,, the income statement was presented and unanimously accepted. After being unanimously elected, the new board of directors appointed the eight-person committee.

The Cœur de Charente Community of Communes has undertaken work to redesign the hiking trails for the communes of the Pays d'Aigre. As part of the maintenance of the trail signs, the community is calling on the help of the Croq'Sentiers association, which counts among its members markers trained by the FFRP as well as volunteers able to support them. An agreement must be drawn up and then signed.

Octobre rose



The commune of Charmé was involved in the Pink October campaign in support of the fight against breast cancer, "an operation carried out by the Departmental Committee of the League against Cancer and locally relayed by the Ruffécois PETR". The facade of the Town Hall and the Church were lit up in pink and pink umbrellas decorated the Town Hall.

Also to be noted is the initiative of the local farmer, Mr. Benoît Fradin, who "decorated" the entrance to the village with straw bales wrapped in pink to mark the occasion.

Tuesday, October 5, during the permanence of "Emmabüs" on the town hall square, Madame LARO AMET, public health officer in New Aquitaine, was present to talk about screening for breast, cervical and colo rectal cancers.

On Wednesday October 6 afternoon, the municipality, in collaboration with the Croq'Sentiers hiking association, organized a solidarity walk of 6 km, from the stadium, for a contribution of € 3 per person. The 50 adults and 5 children who took part in this hike got together, on the way back, for a refreshment and a piece of brioche generously offered by the club.

During this moment of conviviality, Doctor Isabelle REAM from Nanteuil-en-Vallée kindly gave some of her precious time for which we are grateful, to give information about the importance of screening, prevention and support in the context of breast cancer. The exchanges between the attentive audience and Doctor REAM were very interesting.

All of the donations collected, i.e. € 236, were donated to the League against cancer.

Commemoration Of the First World War Armistice



This year, the health conditions allowed the commemoration of the armistice of the First World War to take place, in the presence of a few dozen people including a large representation of the British community and the always faithful Mr. Keith Thomas, formerly of the Royal Air Force.

As you have noticed, an information radar has been installed, in different places, along the RD 736.

This radar allows the recording of average and maximum speeds as well as the estimation of the number of vehicles.

The full results will be available at the end of the campaign scheduled for the month of December.

However, the first results, recorded at the northern entrance to the village, show that one in two vehicles does not respect the 50 km/h limit, and for the maximum speed recorded?

Beyond 122 km/h (75 mph) in the incoming direction (Ruffec towards Aigre)!

Important Messages from La Poste

Dogs



Dog bites are a major cause of postal employees accidents and La Poste naturally attaches particular importance to ensuring that postal employees can perform their job in normal safe conditions.

So that the distribution can be assured without danger, we would ask dog owners to respect the rules below:

- o Keep the gates of your home closed;
- o Make sure your mailbox and bell are out of reach of the animal;
- o Attach or isolate it when the postman is present in the neighborhood.

Adresses



Many undeliverable mail is dropped off at the town hall by the postman, forcing a member of the municipal team to redistribute it to the correct recipient.

The updated address list has been sent to the postal services, but when you notice an error or discrepancy in the wording of your identity or in the address, it is up to you to contact the sender to notify them of the error so that they can update their mailing list.
